Research

The CRAG Project [Children's Research Advisory Group] Y6 took part in a research project involving the Wellcome Trust, School of Education, Queen's University Belfast and Institute of Education and involved discovering parents' and pupils' attitudes to testing and assessment of Science at Key Stage 2.

We are also taking part in the RHS **Campaign for School Gardening** which aims to encourage and support schools to develop and actively use a school garden. The RHS campaign is organised in a series of benchmark levels. The school needs to complete each benchmark level and send evidence to the RHS to receive an award. We have just completed Benchmark 1 and we are applying for Benchmark 2.

One of our Year 6 pupils came 2nd in a competition run by the Institute of Biology. Pupils designed a sculpture of a plant for a botanical garden to show how it is adapted to its habitat.

KS 2 Science SATs

15 of the 21 pupils in Year 6 achieved Level 5 and 6 Level 4

Music

In 2008 The Cavendish became an accredited Associated Board of the Royal Schools of Music (ABRSM) Examination Centre.

During 2008-2009, 125 pupils over a range of 7 instruments including voice were entered for ABRSM examinations with 100% success rate.

30 were awarded Distinctions

53 Merits

83 Merit or Distinction

For the first time a pupil was awarded a Grade 5 for singing.

16 students also sat for ABRSM Preparatory Tests also with 100% pass rate.

Additionally 5 pupils were awarded Music Medals.
