### **Ingredients**

- 125g almond powder
- 80g white sugar
- 60g unsalted butter, softened
- 2 eggs
- 1 egg yolk or beaten egg

**2 sheets of fresh puff pastry**

### **1 Directions**

1. Heat the oven to 200C/fanC180/gas 6.
2. Put one sheet of puff pastry in a baking dish.

Beat together the softened butter and caster sugar until light and fluffy, then beat in the two eggs. Stir

in the ground almonds.

1. Spoon the mixture on the pastry, spreading it evenly. Don't forget to put *la fève* in the mixture. Brush the edges of the pastry with water, then cover with the second piece, pressing the edges to seal. Mark the top of the pastry from the centre to the edges like the spokes of a wheel or in a zig zag pattern, then brush with beaten egg.

Bake for 25-30 mins until crisp and golden. Serve warm or cold.

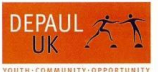
